White Teas

Recommended temperature of service 75° C

Peony Leaf

Snow White is a truly impressive example of white 'Peony', the generic name for Chinese white tea. This delicate tea is a beautiful combination of bright green leaves and soft white buds. Refreshing and cool, Snow White delivers a fragrant, lingering liquor.

Silver Needle*

The finest and most highly prized white tea. Only the freshest soft buds that are ripe for just a few weeks of the year are picked. The delicate flavour has a sweet finish with hints of melon and cucumber.

Blooming Jewel*

Hand-crafted using an artisanal technique dating back thousands of years. The first step is to sift through the leaves and carefully select the freshest tips. A beautiful flower blossom is laid on the tips and then it is carefully tied to form a little bud. As the leaves ease apart a delightful flower and blossom will emerge from within.

Green Teas

Recommended temperature of service 80° C

Sencha

Revered for its healing properties. Our Sencha tea is rich in antioxidants, perfect for everyday drinking, light, delicate, sweet and nutty.

Fine China Jasmine

A favourite of Chinese high society. Produced in Fujian, the green leaves are crowned with delicate silvery buds. The finest jasmine flower brings a light aroma that precedes its sweet and delicate taste.

Sencha springtime

A combination of tea, fruit and flower that is wonderfully balanced. Blending Japanese Sencha; green and white teas from China; a smattering of redcurrants, blackcurrants and apricot bits; and cornflower and jasmine blossoms.

Formosa Oolong *

Oolong tea originated from Formosa Mountains in Taiwan. After picking, the leaves are fermented and then wilted in the sun. Frequent turning of the tea in bamboo baskets during the drying process allows the Oolong to develop a mild aroma and a large wildy curled leaf. It is light in the cup and has a flowery, spicy taste.

Milk Oolong *

Milk Oolong, sometimes called silk oolong, has such a unique taste that many romantic stories have evolved to explain its unusual flavour. The explanation of the sweet milk and light orchid notes is the result of the sudden shift in temperature during harvest in Fujian Provence. It is an exceptional connoisseur oolong.

Japanese Tea Ceremony

Matcha*

Matcha is made of the finest powdered green tea leaves and is served in the famous Japanese tea ceremony which can be traced back to the 11th century. Our Matcha is ceremonial grade and comes from Uji, in the Kyoto region of Japan where the finest Matcha teas are crafted. The infusion is rich and vegetal yet mellow and slightly sweet. It contains about ten times more antioxidants than a normal cup of green tea.

Lapsang Souchong

A unique tea from the famous Wuyi Mountains in Fujian Province, Lapsang Souchong yields dark red liquor with a distinctive smoky aroma and flavour, which results from its special processing. Its leaves are withered over pine fires, pan-fired and rolled, and then pressed into wooden barrels covered with cloth to oxidize. After another firing, the leaves are rolled into tight strips and left over smoking pine fires to dry.

Offering soothing richness and instant focus, Classic Chai is a mesmerising blend of black tea, cardamom, cloves, cinnamon pieces, fennel, aniseeds, ginger and black pepper. This spicy chai infusion can be enjoyed straight or with milk and sugar for the ultimate taste sensation.
